

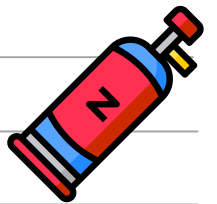
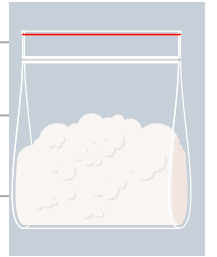


All About Ice Cream

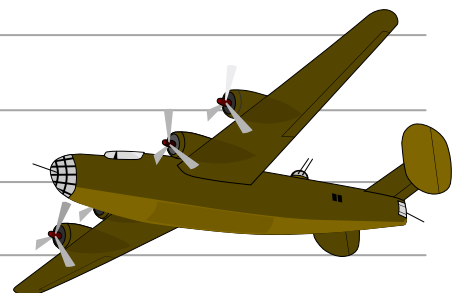
1. Why was ice cream a luxury dessert before the 1900s?
