

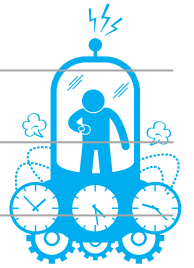


Radical Roller Coasters

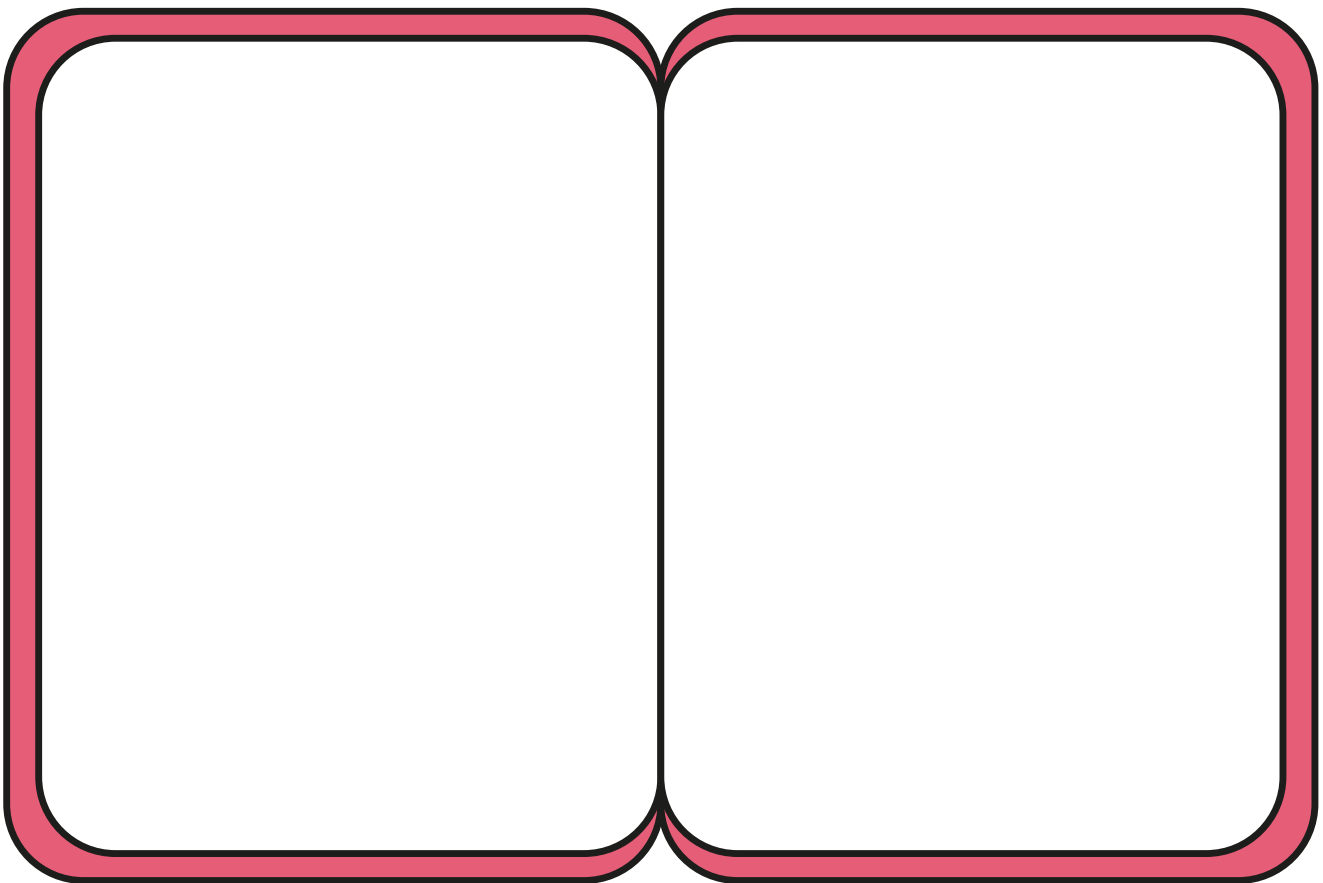
