

## Horses

- Average speed 45km/h, slower on sand
- Needs a rest after about 8 hours
- Can carry up to 20% of weight
- Can live 3-6 days without water
- Temperatures over 25 degrees can lead to stress

## Camels

- Average speed 20km/h, faster on sand
- Can travel for 18 hours without rest
- Can carry up to 40% of weight
- Can last two weeks without water
- Can handle temps of up to 50 degrees
