3. Name some types of videos that kids might watch on YouTube during school holidays. Amanda mentioned science, sports and music. How many more can you think of?



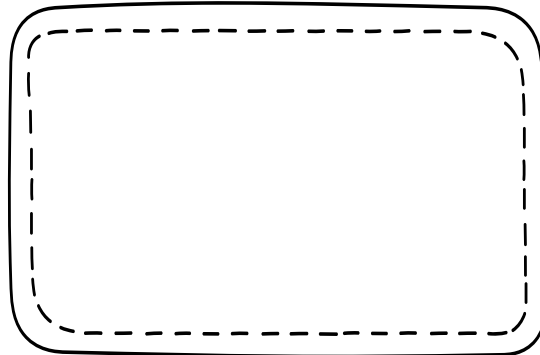
4. If you were going to make a YouTube channel, what would you call it?
