And via the short interviews with university academics in the field, some popular misconceptions are addressed.

Kids hear plenty about the threat of climate change, and it doubtless contributes to the general sense of anxiety that comes from growing up in a world of information overload. This podcast series - and the classroom worksheets that come with it - is about getting kids excited about the possibilities of science and technology and a future where clever humans are finding solutions for a sustainable future.
